As a Business Intelligence (BI) Analyst, you will be expected to contribute to the development of the business through accurate and effective QlikView and QlikSense performance reports.

Working as part of BI team you will have strong analytical, report development and data processing skills.

The core objective for this position will be delivering on the BI strategy. This role will focus on dashboard and KPI reporting.

The BI developer will be responsible for the technical design, construction, delivery and support for all areas surrounding the airports business intelligence solution. You will be a key contributor to the data warehouse and business intelligence strategy.

Lead employees using a performance management and development process that provides coaching, mentoring, and developing staff, including overseeing training and providing career development planning and opportunities.

Key Responsibilities:

- Responsibility for the recruitment, management, training, development and welfare of Junior Business Intelligence Analyst / CrowdVision analyst roles.
- Develop accurate performance reports and dashboards; typically using QlikSense, QlikView and Business Objects
- Be the first point of contact for QlikView queries and take the lead in the development or amendments of reporting dashboards
- Provide support to other analysts including on the job coaching and assessing training needs
- Sharing your knowledge with business users through training courses, blogs and one to one sessions
- Ensure the integrity of data contained within the QlikView models
- Deliver agreed performance reports to agreed timescales
- Add value to the BI team by providing trend analysis alongside suggesting future developments
- Continual improvement of the BI front end to support changing business needs
- Ensure efficient, effective, and metric driven data visualisation and information delivery
- Work directly with Information Technology on technical development and platform management
- Develops and implements the strategy for the delivery of information / insight in a form which is simple for users and encourages 'self service'

Working Conditions
